## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE

BY-LAW ///-86

BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE THE SALE OF NEWSPAPERS MAGAZINES, PERIODICALS, PAMPHLETS OR OTHER PRINTED MATTER ON HIGHWAYS IN THE TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville deems it expedient to regulate the sale of newspapers, magazines, periodicals, pamphlets or other printed matter.

THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville enacts as follows:

- No person shall offer for sale, or expose samples for delivery, any newspapers, magazines, periodicals, pamphlets or other printed matter on any public highway in the Town of Orangeville in the following locations:
  - a) Within fifty (50) feet of any intersection.
  - b) Adjacent to any property zoned residential or any vacant lot.
  - c) Within three (3) feet of the travelled portion of a highway.
  - d) On the side of any road where parking, stopping or standing is prohibited.
- 2. THAT any person who contravenes this by-law is liable upon conviction of a fine not to exceed \$2,000.00.
- 3. THAT this by-law shall come into force upon the date of its passing.
