

## Rezoning Fees (2020)

- Major: \$10,457.00
- Minor: \$5,228.00
- Credit Valley Conservation fees may be applicable

## Public Notification Signs

- The applicant will pay \$265.55 per sign to the Town of Orangeville for the purposes of preparing and installing a public notification sign on the property
- If the property is on the corner of two or more roads, one notification sign per street frontage is required
- The Town will make the necessary arrangements to have the sign(s) prepared and installed on the property and eventually removed

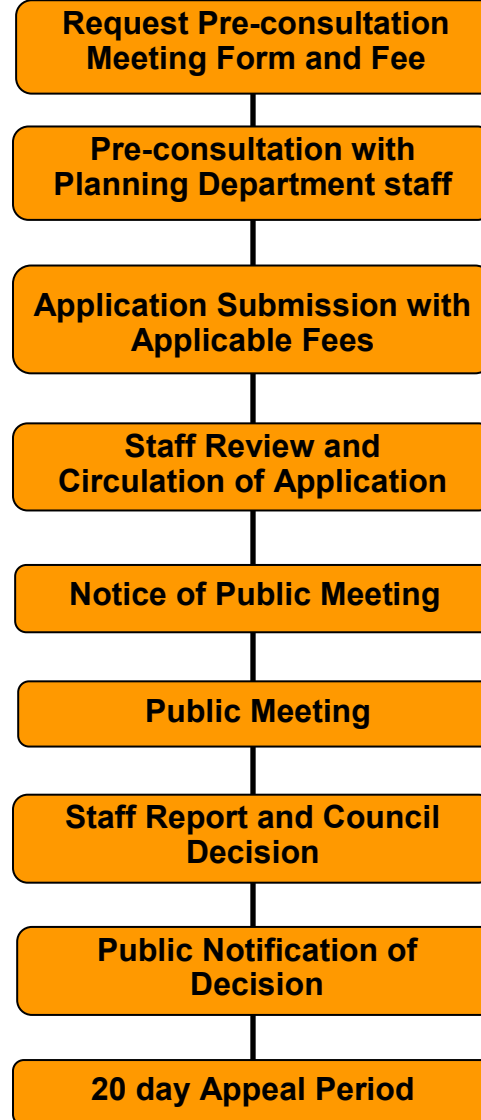

## Rezoning Process

- Orangeville's Zoning By-law (22-90) regulates the use of land, buildings and other structures
- The Zoning By-law divides the Town into land use zones
- For each zone, the By-law specifies uses and regulations
- All development proposals **MUST** comply with the Town's Zoning By-law
- The rezoning process allows for Council's consideration of zoning changes
- Land rezoning is a change in the zone of a property or area
- Any changes **MUST** still conform to the Town's Official Plan
- This process usually takes 4 to 6 months; complex applications can take longer

## Rezoning Application Checklist

An application for a rezoning must contain the following:

- Completed General Planning Application Form for Zoning By-law Amendment.
- A cheque made payable to the Town of Orangeville for the application fee
- 1 copy of a scaled drawing of the proposal depicting the lot, the location and size of the existing and proposed buildings, and other relevant features
- Digital copies of all plans and drawings
- If you are using an agent or solicitor, your written authorization identifying by name the individual who will be your agent or solicitor
- Other studies as required
