

# **Guide to Establishing a Home-Based Business in the Town of Orangeville**

#### What is a Home-Based Business?

A home-based business is an occupation conducted for profit or gain entirely within a *dwelling unit*. In the Town of Orangeville, home-based businesses are known as "home occupations". The Town's Zoning By-law classifies home occupations into Class A, B or C categories, each of which are permitted in certain types of dwellings and must comply with specific criteria.

#### Home Occupation - Class A - permitted in all dwelling types:

- business and professional offices (other than that of a medical, dental or chiropractic practitioner or veterinarian).
- an artist's studio for the production of arts, crafts, film arts or other similar works (but not including an audio recording studio).
- a teacher or tutor other than a music teacher; and,
- a dressmaker, tailor, or seamstress.

# Home Occupation – Class B – permitted only in semi-detached and single detached dwellings:

- office of a medical, dental or chiropractic practitioner or veterinarian.
- hairdresser, beautician, barber, massage therapist, reflexologist or dietician.
- repair of small appliances and mechanical equipment; and,
- a bed and breakfast establishment

# Home Occupation - Class C - permitted only in single detached dwellings:

- a music teacher.
- private-home daycare not to exceed five (5) children; and,
- an audio recording studio.

All permitted home occupations must also comply with the requirements of the Ontario Building Code Act and the Fire Marshall's Act (*By-law 50-94*).

Note: Retail sales are not permitted from any home occupation.

# **General Regulations / Frequently Asked Questions:**

### Is there a maximum size that my home-based business can be?

The floor area for a home-based business is limited to a maximum 30 m<sup>2</sup> or maximum 25% of the floor area of the dwelling, whichever is lesser. A bed and breakfast establishment may exceed these floor area limitations; however, the maximum number of guest bedrooms is three. The home occupation is to be secondary to the main residential use.

### Can I operate my home-based business out of my garage or shed?

No. The home occupation is to be conducted entirely within the dwelling. Accessory buildings (garages or sheds) cannot be used.

#### Can I store materials on the property or display items for sale on my lawn?

No. External storage, exposure, advertising, or display of goods is prohibited.

### Can I advertise my business?

External display or advertising is not permitted, except in accordance with the Town's Sign By-law. According to the By-law, a non-illuminated wall sign with a maximum area of 0.2 m<sup>2</sup> identifying the building, occupants, or the home occupation is permitted. #### What about noise?

No mechanical equipment which would cause a nuisance through noise, vibration or interference with television or radio reception may be used.

# How many employees can I hire?

A maximum of one employee who is not a resident of the dwelling may be permitted.

# Am I allowed to operate more than one home occupation in my home?

No, only one home occupation is permitted per dwelling unit.

# Do I need to provide additional parking on my property for my employees and customers?

The minimum parking requirement for all home occupations other than a bed and breakfast establishment is one parking space for each 20 m<sup>2</sup> of home occupation area, plus one space for any non-resident employee. A bed and breakfast must provide one parking space for each guest bedroom. A parking space is at least 2.7 m by 5.5 m in size and must have unobstructed access to a street by a driveway.

# What approvals do I need from the Town of Orangeville before opening my home-based business?

The Town of Orangeville does not require a municipal licence to operate a home-based business. However, the provisions in the Town's Zoning By-law and other applicable by-laws must be followed.

# I want to renovate my home to accommodate my home-based business. Do I need to get a building permit?

If you are considering any construction or alteration to the home, such as making structural changes, finishing your basement, creating a new access, or installing plumbing for sinks or washrooms, you will

### I want to start a food business to sell to the public. What approvals do I need?

Food prepared for public consumption requires a kitchen that is entirely independent from the home kitchen. This kitchen will be inspected as per the Ontario Food Premises Regulation 493/17, by a Public Health Inspector.
